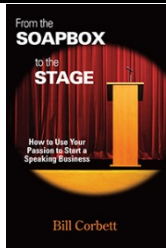

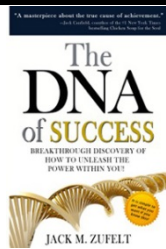


FROM THE SOAPBOX TO THE STAGE...
